# Non-Recyclable

These items can never be placed in your recycling container.

- Aerosol cans
- Aluminum foil
- Batteries
- Mirrors or ceramics
- Food waste
- Stickers & address labels
- Tissue, paper towels or napkins
- Scrap metal
- Plastic bags

## Non-recyclable items that require special handling:

- Incandescent light bulbs
- Fluorescent tubes
- Computers & electronics
- Needles or syringes
- Hazardous waste
- Paint
- Toxic material containers

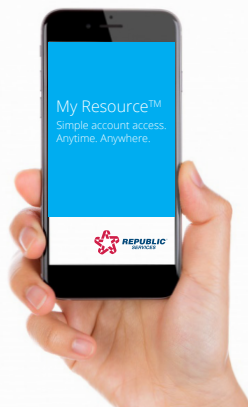

In this program, you receive a 95-gallon wheeled waste container with a dark blue or black lid and a 95-gallon wheeled recycling container with a light blue lid. Recycling is collected every other week on the same day as your waste service. Waste is collected once per week on your regularly scheduled service day. In Denver, two thirds of our fleet is running on CNG while the remaining vehicles run on diesel. Please refrain from using your own recycling or waste container. Our trucks are equipped to handle the 95-gallon containers provided to you.

Easily access your account 24/7. Your time is valuable. Schedule a pickup, pay your bill and discover new services anytime, anywhere, on any device with the **My Resource™** app.



## Service Tips

- Please place your containers at the curb by 7 a.m. on your scheduled service day with the wheels against the curb and at least three feet apart.
- Please place containers eight feet away from objects such as mail boxes and parked cars.
- We encourage you to place your waste in a bag before tossing in the waste container with the dark blue or black lid.
- Please do not bag your recyclables; just place them directly in the recycling container with the light blue lid. There is no need to sort or separate.
- Flatten and bundle boxes no more than 3'x3'x3'.
- Please do not overfill your container. The lid should close fully.
- Recycling, waste and bulky items are emptied by different trucks at different times of the day. Each truck goes through your neighborhood once on the service day.
- Moving? Contact us to transfer service or remove containers.
- Republic Services offers a disability service if you are unable to roll your containers to the street. Please call us for more information.
- Pay by phone available by calling 877.692.9729.
- We're closed on the 4th of July, Labor Day, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Service will be one day delayed if either of these holidays fall during the week AND on or before your service day.
- For household hazardous waste and/or medical waste, please contact us for disposal options.
- Please call us if your containers require repair or replacement due to damage.



### Extra Bags

Each resident may have one 95-gallon waste container each week, unless otherwise specified by a city contract or HOA. For the occasional times when you have more than the weekly limit, please contact customer service for assistance. Additional recycling and waste containers are also available if the above limits do not fit your needs (additional service fees apply).



### Bulk Pickup

Please call 24 hours in advance of the requested service dates to schedule a bulk pickup for items such as furniture, landscape waste and large bulky items. Additional service fees apply. Prepayment is required. No items containing Freon are accepted. Contact customer service for disposal options. Bundles must be 4' in length, 18" high, 18" deep.
